SAN LUIS VALLEY FAIR BOARD MEMBERSHIP GUIDELINES

1. The San Luis Valley Fair is an annual event that brings together kids, livestock, fun and educational events, and showcases 4-H and FFA members and San Luis Valley community projects. The SLV Fair Board provides oversight and management of this event, in cooperation with the Fair Office and the County 4-H Extension Staff.
2. Board meetings are held the 2nd Monday of each month at 7:00 p.m. Oct-March, 7:30 p.m. April-Sep. at the San Luis Valley Extension Office Building, in Monte Vista, CO. Members will be notified of any changes in dates and/or locations.
3. Board meeting attendance is critical to the efficient management of the Fair. Therefore, a board member with more than three (3) consecutive absences, or 50% of monthly meetings absences in one year may be excused and a replacement named at the discretion of fair board.
4. Extensive involvement of all board members is critical throughout the Fair, the first week in August, in order for all events and shows to be conducted in an organized and timely manner.
5. Special board meetings are held daily at a designated time determined by fair board during the week of the fair to evaluate events and resolve issues which may occur. These meetings are required for all board members.
